"More than ever, what we are reading can shape our views, our moods, and our knowledge. Years ago I came across a list of one hundred books of which were then modern literature and which came with the provision that if read, would be the equivalent of a college education. It is called 'Connolly's 100' named for Cyril Connolly, an important but colorful and controversial editor of *Horizon*, the important literary publication of its day, with George Orwell, W.H. Auden, and Evelyn Waugh as frequent contributors. Have no doubt that it is still a definitive list of the important authors of the modern era, to which I'd only add a few, namely Simone de Beauvoir, Saul Bellow, Henry Miller, Edith Wharton, and Dashiell Hammett. (There may well be many others who deserve to be on the list, for me Jeffrey Eugenides, Dave Eggers, and... oops, if I start this it will become a list of 200!)"
