by renowned veteran journalist Robert Whitley, where we were honored with our second **Winery of the Year** award this year! With fourteen of our wines receiving **Gold** or better at the *Critics Challenge*, we were delighted to hear that the two highest scoring wines in the

competition were our 2013 Archimedes and 2013 Eleanor. In addition to earning **98 points**, our 2013 Archimedes was given the **Director's Award for Wine of the Year**.

2014 Archimedes New Vintage!

79% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Malbec **92+ Points** – The Wine Advocate **Double Gold** – Wine Spectator Magazine

Crafted for the true connoisseur, Archimedes is produced in very limited quantities from the vintage's most impressive lots of Cabernet Sauvignon. The 2014 vintage offered an outstanding crop of extremely high-quality fruit with tremendous concentration due to persistent dry, warm weather. Extracted and textural on the palate with ample tannin structure, the initial perfume is redolent of baked boysenberries, violets, and Mexican cocoa. Lush, spicy flavors of blackberries, black plums, and currants are accented by mineral expressions of graphite. As the wine opens up, red fruits begin to emerge along with notes of anise and smoky oak. This vintage is a true beauty, complex and dramatic with great length.

In 1860, one thousand men undertook a dangerous sea expedition led by Giuseppe Garibaldi leading to the collapse of the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies, and the unification of one nation. One of the thousand volunteers was Francis's Great Grandfather, Francesco Pennino. To commemorate their brave actions, each man was given a certificate signed by Giuseppe Garibaldi. As our own tribute to these men, we have enclosed a reproduction of this certificate for you to keep as a memento. We invite you to lift your glass and pay homage to the red shirts that changed history.

Full of ripeness, the resulting wine is exceptionally balanced because of its solid structure. Full-bodied, dark, and inky this powerhouse Petite Sirah offers rich flavors of black currants, boysenberries, and cherries, along with notes of mocha and espresso. There's great complexity here and the flavors keep evolving as the wine opens up, making our 2014 I Mille extremely compelling.
