Our Diamond Collection Golden Tier Pinot Noir continues this tradition by being the first wine in the portfolio to hail from the state of Oregon. Grown in an appellation that experiences cool summers and mild winters, this Pinot Noir offers an exciting contrast to our California bottling, expressing a more delicate tannin structure and higher acidity that makes it elegant and well-proportioned. This wine reflects the essence of the appellation and flavors that make Oregon Pinot Noir so desirable.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Our 2019 Oregon Pinot Noir is dark garnet in color, with aromas of blackberry and ripe cranberry, predominantly fruity notes with some well-integrated oak. Flavors are harmonious with the presence of raspberry and pomegranate that fill the palate. The wine is supple and flowing; the body is ample and velvety. The mid palate presents a layered structure of well melted tannins. This complex Pinot Noir has a rich body with a luscious finish.
