When I first visited Belize, I was searching for the same jungle paradise I'd enjoyed while shooting Apocalypse Now in the Philippines. I found it tucked away in the Maya Mountains - Blancaneaux Lodge. Years later, I established its coastal companion, Turtle Inn, on the white beaches of the small Creole fishing village of Placencia. Then, we discovered La Lancha in Guatemala, a lakeside lodge near Tikal, one of the archaeological wonders of the world.

Buenos Aires was my home for two years while filming Tetro and Jardin Escondido, provided a peaceful, and intimate sanctuary in the vibrant Palermo Soho district. The secret garden is an oasis to be enjoyed in an exciting city.





BLANCANEAUX LODGE

A dramatic hideaway in a rainforest wonderland

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In the early 1980s, Francis Ford Coppola visited Belize, immediately fell in love with the country, and purchased the abandoned Blancaneaux Lodge. For more than a decade the resort was used as a family retreat before Francis opened his tropical paradise to the public in 1993. Guests can explore the ancient civilization of the Maya, which still endures in sacred sites throughout this magical region. From the ceremonial caves along the white-water rivers of the Mountain Pine Ridge Reserve to stalactite caverns and the vast ruins of the ancient metropolis of Caracol deep within the lush rainforest, Blancaneaux is your window into a world of natural and archaeological wonders. Tucked away in a pocket of the Maya Mountains, Blancaneaux Lodge is a 20-room luxury resort hotel in Belize where waterfalls tumble into turquoise pools above the jungle canopy. The Lodge's remote mountain setting makes it the perfect place to relax, rejuvenate and enjoy life's simple pleasures.



Natural Waters & Swimming Pool

Over a thousand streams begin their journey in the Mountain Pine Ridge Forest Reserve, while the smooth granite boulders, sandy beaches, and waterfalls of Privassion Creek provide some of the Reserve's best natural swimming holes. Swim in the deep, cool pools close to the Lodge or explore the hidden rock pools leading to the stunning Big Rock Falls, a must see for the adventurous.

Our fresh water infinity pool is set between the main lodge and the Guatemaltecqua Restaurant and is decorated with brightly-colored ceramic tiles and surrounded by a stone patio. Handmade mahogany sun loungers surround the edge of the pool while our 'Captains' are on-hand to provide towels and take drink orders from the bar.

Spa

Set on the banks of Privassion Creek, our Waterfall Spa offers a variety of treatments, wraps and massages, as well as access to our rejuvenating hot pool overlooking cascading waterfalls. Our Belize spa specializes in the art of Thai massage, and features a professionally trained staff that has studied the ancient techniques at the Sacred Wat Pho Temple in Bangkok.

In addition to providing you with the best spa experience possible, we are also committed to maintaining strict sustainability guidelines. With a hot pool heated solely by hydro-electricity, spa treatments that use only locally sourced organic ingredients and an open building design utilizing natural light, the Waterfall Spa is eco-luxury at its best.

Classic Italian cuisine in a romantic tropical setting. Our menu features traditional Italian dishes with a special focus on the Coppolas' personal family recipes, drawn from their roots in the southern region of Basilicata. Pastas, fresh fish, and braised or grilled local meats are all prepared with organically-grown herbs and vegetables from our own garden. Our restaurant also offers made-to-order pizza, cooked in an authentic brick oven.

Our intimate dining room sparkles from candlelight and is decorated with handmade wooden furnishings, colonial era antiques and Guatemalan fabrics. An open veranda offers moonlit views of Privassion Creek.





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Jaguar Bar

After a day of tours and activities, the Jaguar Bar is a perfect place to relax. The hand-carved slate bar, ceiling fans from the set of Apocalypse Now, historic photos of local archaeological digs, and handmade furnishings create a truly exotic atmosphere.

The bar offers a selections of fine wines and classic cocktails including favorites such as mojitos and daiquiris, as well as our very own Jaguar Juice, a potent concoction of local craboo liqueur, aged rum, and fresh pineapple juice.

Cooking Class

Belize showcases diverse cultural influences in many ways whether you visit Mayan ruins during your stay or discover the variety through the cuisine. At Blancaneaux Lodge guests may choose to participate in an experience that takes them into the kitchen to cook a menu they will choose representing the traditions of local Belizeans whether of Creole, Garifuna or Mestizo descent. All cultures are harmonious here and feature unique dishes to discover.











Guatemaltecqua Restaurant

Our poolside restaurant specializes in the cooking of Guatemala, a mildly-spiced cuisine that draws on Mexican, Caribbean and Mayan influences. Local favorites include Salpicon, a shredded beef salad flavored with sour orange and cilantro, Jocon, chicken cooked with green herbs and spices, and Rellenitos, a delicious dessert consisting of plantains filled with sweetened black beans.

Organic Garden

At Blancaneaux Lodge, the produce is truly local. Our gardening staff grows all of the organic vegetables and many of the fruits used at the lodge. Despite the challenges presented by gardening in the jungle, Francis and Eleanor Coppola felt that fresh, flavorful produce was worth the effort. "We want to offer our guests the best there is, and by growing it ourselves we can guarantee the quality," says Francis. "Besides, what's the use of a good brick oven pizza without fresh basil?"





Guests who visit our garden will see familiar backyard varieties growing next to exotic fruits and vegetables. Blancaneaux's elevation and cool evening temperatures make it possible to grow a myriad of leaf lettuces, radishes, beans, carrots, and beets, as well as fresh herbs such as basil, oregano, cilantro, and dill.

Our gardener and chef consult daily on what is available for the day's menu and what will soon be ready to make an appearance. The year-round growing season and careful crop rotation means there are always fresh tomatoes for salads, sandwiches, pizzas and pastas.




Francis Ford Coppola's Villa

Enjoy dramatic views from the elevated open-plan living, area, take a dip in the private pool or relax on the hardwood sun deck set in a lush tropical garden. The villa features a small kitchen with Delonghi espresso machine, fridge and wet bar. A hand-carved antique dining table with seating for up to 14 overlooks the tumbling waterfalls and deep rock pools of Privassion Creek. Accommodations include two large bedrooms each with a spacious bathroom featuring showers with hand-painted tiles and Japanese tubs. The eclectically furnished villa combines regional antiques, Guatemalan fabrics, artisan masks and hand-carved figurines. Francis's personal art and antiques are displayed throughout, adding a personal touch to an uniquely comfortable and stylish environment.

Enchanted Cottage

Blancaneaux Lodge's ultimate retreat. Reflecting Francis's desire to create a haven in which to reflect, write, and create, the cottage sits atop a steep forested bluff offering panoramic views over the tumbling waterfalls of Privassion Creek and the distant jungle clad Maya Mountains.





With an emphasis on luxury, the cottage features a bedroom with a king-size bed, writing desk, and fireplace. The bath house provides understated luxury with its underfloor heating, open fire, shower, Japanese tub, and steam room. The cottage has a spacious kitchen that includes a wine cooler, Delonghi espresso machine, a breakfast bar and a heated slate floor. Adjacent to the kitchen is an airy day room with queen-size sofa bed, large coffee table, and comfortable armchair. Screened doors open onto the hardwood deck and the infinity pool. The Enchanted Cottage is secluded and surrounded by lush tropical gardens and spectacular panoramic views. After a day of exploration and adventure, unwind in your personal hammock.

The second largest lake in Guatemala, Lago Petén Itzá is famous for its dramatic changes in color, shifting from cobalt blue to a green turquoise hue in an instant. Local Traditions and Vistas


The mirador area is a peaceful setting to take in the views of the lake below or have a private dinner for two or indulge in an al-fresco Mayan moon oil massage.

Restaurant

La Lancha's open-air restaurant is situated under the main lodge's thatch roof, with spectacular views of the forest canopy and nearby Lago Petén Itzá. Enjoy a hearty breakfast accompanied by the morning chorus of parakeets and ground



doves, along with the occasional call of the resident howler monkeys. Dinner features authentic Guatemalan dishes such as Chilaquiles, beef tenderloin served with chiltepe peppercorn sauce grilled on the open parilla, and Suban Ik ('God's meal'), a traditional dish containing chicken, beef, rice, and spices.

From the main lodge, winding paths lead to a variety of casitas and suites to choose from, many with views of the lake or the rainforest.





Rainforest Junior Suites

Private and intimate, each has a king-size bed, a main living area with a sleeper sofa, full bathroom with shower and dual shower heads, and a wooden deck set up with chairs and hammocks to take in the balmy evenings. Hand-picked artifacts, furniture and décor from around the area lend to the exotic feel of the accommodation.






Lakeview Suites

Tikal

Perhaps the most visually stunning and impressive of all Maya sites, Tikal's five monolithic temples pierce the jungle canopy (Temple IV reaches a height of almost 230 feet) and ancient plazas, stelae and ball courts tell of a rich and powerful history when Tikal's population reached almost 100,000. Today the site is recognized as one of the archeological wonders of the Americas. Its unspoiled jungle setting within the Tikal National Park makes it a paradise for birders, nature lovers, and amateur archaeologists.

Jardin Escondido

A secret garden in a vibrant and artistic neighborhood

Located in Palermo Soho, one of the most vibrant neighborhoods in Buenos Aires, is the lush, green oasis of Jardin Escondido. Boasting three levels of gardens, an outdoor kitchen and parrilla, and a beautiful terrace surrounded by plants, the setting is truly a hidden paradise. The vibrant cultural scene of this exciting city in South America is combined with a peaceful escape to an intimate seven room hotel that feels more like a home.





Accommodations include intimate junior-sized suites and simpler guestrooms and all enjoy access to the library, central garden courtyard and living room where breakfast is served family style every day and many guests linger in the evenings sipping Argentinian wine and taking in a Coppola film. A traditional Argentine barbecue can be arranged on the parrilla.
