LOCATION: Coral Caye is a completely privatized island experience. It is an exclusive experience on a two-acre island, located eight miles from Placencia and Turtle Inn (about a 25 min boat ride).

The island appeals to both couples seeking an intimate and completely exclusive retreat and families or friends who may seek a Robinson Crusoe style escape.

A dedicated staff of a butler/caretaker and chef are on the island to prepare meals, housekeeping services, provide snorkeling tips and any day to day service needs. For a more elaborate event or menu requests, additional chefs and massage therapists can be arranged at additional cost.

The island is enjoyed by one party at a time. Whether booked by a couple or a party of ten, it will be enjoyed exclusively by those guests.

HISTORY: Set in the Caribbean sea with panoramic views of the sunrise, stars and a few smaller cayes, guests feel a million miles away, though they are only 25 minutes away from the shoreline of Placencia, Belize. The island was taken over by the Coppola Family in the

Fall of 2016 and feels like an extension of the charming, barefoot elegant experience of Turtle Inn.

DÉCOR:

The coastal decor consists of airy fabrics, open space, seaside-inspired colors, beachy accents, sturdy woods to withstand sandy feet and salty air, and tones to reflect the sea and sky. Two dwellings and a great house are the only buildings on the island and can accommodate from two to ten guests.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Two guest cottages are on the island and a third cottage is enjoyed as a “great house” or gathering space with indoor/outdoor living room feel, bar, board games and an additional daybed and half bathroom, so it too can be utilized as an overnight accommodation.

Coral Cottage

The newly built dwelling, is ideal for a couple seeking privacy and romance or a family with young children. It has a king bed and a sleeper sofa in the cozy living area, front porch, hammocks and full bathroom with an indoor and outdoor shower. *Maximum occupancy of three adults or two adults and two young children.*

Seahorse Cottage

Ideal for extended family or additional friends, the seahorse cottage is situated near the Mangrove Cove where one can find many seahorses. It features two queen beds, one additional twin bed and an adjacent bathroom with a shower. *Maximum occupancy of six people.*

Great House

A charming, sand floor, indoor/outdoor living room space with amenities including a full bar, music system, half bathroom, kitchen, dining table, board games, dart board and more this space for celebration or family meals can be converted in the evening to accommodate added guests with daybeds.

All international flights to Belize arrive at Philip S. W. Goldson International Airport (BZE) in Belize City. Airlines include:

How to get to Coral Caye:**Travelers have 3 options, arriving first to Placencia:**

Tropic Air or Maya Air offer scheduled flights to Placencia from either Belize Municipal (TZA) or Belize International (BZE).

Astrum Helicopters transfer from Belize International to land right on site (at charge)

Private driver pick up can also be arranged from Belize International Airport (at charge)

(Complimentary pick up upon arrival at the Placencia air strip)

Turtle Inn's boat Gia will take up to 8 passengers and supplies. (Suggested to arrive timely so the boat can arrive on the island before dark). The boat drops guests off on the west side of the island. Guests receive the typical Turtle Inn welcome (cold towel, welcome drink) by your butler. Guests can also sail to the island with charter sail boats from The Moorings at an additional cost.
